A2070 KENNINGTON ROAD, ASHFORD

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2017

To allow road widening works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of the A2070 Kennington Road, Ashford.

A closure is planned from Tuesday 20 June 2017 for an estimated period of up to 11 weeks.

A2070 Kennington Road will be closed in the vicinity of Longport Bridge, which is between the junction with Blackwall Road North and the factories.

~ There will be no direct access between Junction 10 Willesborough Interchange and Spearpoint Corner (Kennington) during these works ~

The alternative route is via A2070 Kennington Road to Spearpoint Corner, A28 Canterbury Road, Simone Weil Avenue, Drovers Roundabout, Templer Way, Chart Road, B2229 Brookfield Road, Leacon Road, Victoria Road, A2042 Romney Marsh Road, A2070 Bad Munstereifel Road and Willesborough Interchange back to A2070 Kennington Road.

Access to the remainder of A2070 Kennington Road will continue from either direction up to where the road is closed, but there will be no through access.

Pedestrian access will continue to be maintained at all times.

Due to the nature of these works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

For the safety of the public whilst an alternative exit from William Harvey Hospital is being used during these works, a temporary mandatory speed limit of 30 mph will be imposed on The Street, Willesborough and Hinxhill Road, Brook / Wye. This applies in both directions from existing 30 mph signs near the junction with Kennington Road to the vicinity of Ousley Farm, to the extent indicated by 30 mph signage clearly displayed on site.
